#### **Message from the Conference**




Thanks to all who have offered their voices to the conversations and work of the VT Conference UCC Racial Justice Task Force.






## VERMONT'S REPRODUCTIVE LIBERTY AMENDMENT

decisions, like whether and
when to become pregnant, use
temporary or permanent birth
control, or seek abortion care.
