#### **Message from the Conference**




Dear Beloved Community in the Vermont Conference,

I am deeply grateful for the Sabbatical time given to me by this Conference. Sabbath time enabled me to truly rest and to reconnect with what is important and necessary and sacred. The gift of this time

enabled me to reconnect and spend quality time with Peg and our family. I reconnected with friends. I spent a lot of time with God, sorting and examining, letting go and recommitting to those activities and practices that are life giving for me and necessary for the health of my spirit, mind and body. I went fly fishing and spent evenings on our deck watching the bats take to the sky and the descending darkness light up one small firefly at a time. I played music alone and with my dulcimer friends. I took a couple of beginner classes in watercolor where I learned about the interaction between water and paint and learned to see more creatively.

I did not read a stack of books on various aspects of church, but I did have the time and space to think and pray about the world. the changing nature of church and specifically about the pastors and congregations of this Conference. #### \*\*\*Furthermore\*\*\*

Our Conference along with the New Hampshire Conference received information that a group known as the Free Staters has published a listing of "woke churches." I think this is an issue our churches should be aware of. To describe this to you I am using excerpts from an article written by my colleague, Gordon Rankin, Conference Minister in New Hampshire.

The target audience for this list of "woke churches" is those who do not want to find themselves in such a church.

The criteria to be considered a "woke" church (according to the Free Staters) is one of the following four things: 1) being LGBTQ affirming, 2) being involved in racial or social justice, 3) having continuing Covid protocols, or 4) being affirming of Ukraine. Later in the week, there was also a similar listing for Jewish faith communities.

As best we can tell, all the information on this list comes from the websites and social media postings of the various churches and synagogues. In other words, it is all information that is already public.

We share this news so that there is awareness among our churches. We encourage continuing the same safe church strategies that are used regularly. At this time, we are not encouraging our churches to do anything reactively as it can increase potential risk.

I especially want to underscore this final statement in Gordon's article:

I would remind us that it is important that we not allow our faith commitments to be silenced at such a time as this. (It is certainly possible that trying to silence the faith witness of such churches and synagogues is part of the intent of such a list.) Our siblings in the LGBTQIA+ communities and in communities of color often find themselves in vulnerable places. If our faith witness is silenced, their vulnerability is only increased. Our voices for justice need to be even louder when things get uncomfortable.

Let us be informed, aware and faithful to the gospel call of radical welcome and a just world for all. If you hear or experience issues with the "woke church list" please let the Conference know.


# **November Trip to El Salvador**




You are invited! Yes, you! Bethany

This is not a work trip; it is about visiting friends and making new ones, being present in solidarity with people in their struggles, and learning about issues that touch on our responsibilities as Christians and as U.S. citizens. Past participants include members of churches in Montpelier, East Montpelier, Barre, Berlin, Waterbury, Randolph, Sherburne, Castleton, Thetford, and Brattleboro, which has its own Salvadoran sister parish. We have no firm dates or costs yet; we're trying for the beginning of November and the cost in the past has been around \$1,200, including flights.
