Dear Beloved Community in the Vermont Conference,

I recently read a story written by a woman who almost committed suicide by jumping off a bridge. She wrote that just as she was getting up her courage to jump, a car sped by and the passenger yelled, "Don't jump!" Because of that one encounter, she did not jump and did find a way back to a life of purpose, meaning and joy. She reflected that often it is not a big, heroic act that changes things, but the small everyday kindnesses we practice.

How true this has been for me in my season of grief. There have been so many small kindnesses. Meals were provided, one even included a small array of flowers in a paper cup. Emails and Facebook posts expressed sympathy, wishes for peace and comfort and sometimes a story of that person's encounter with Peg. Our VTCUCC staff have been incredibly supportive. Flowers and plants have arrived from the Conference, National Church entities, pastors and churches and from friends near and far. Then, there are the cards, so many! I read every single one and give thanks for the sender. Some I read to our adult children. Some contain little gifts of a scripture, a poem, a blessing. These cards and the words they contain are precious to me.

These small kindnesses accompany me, especially in the dark moments of grief. How am I? I am grateful, exhausted, smiling at memories, teary, bereft of Peg's physical presence, at peace with her dying, and feeling the prayers and love that are holding me and my family together. I am back to work as much as I can be right now.



Thank you for your patience as I return gradually to my full schedule. My heart is full of gratitude. I give thanks for 38 years with Peg and the loving family we have. I give thanks for this Conference, our pastors and congregations. I give thanks to God who sustains us day by day, especially when ambushed by grief.

So many small kindnesses! Thank you, thank you, thank you.
