## Season of Creation 2023

### A Mighty River Amos 5: 24

We are still in the Season of Creation and we are increasingly amazed at the number of events and demonstrations in favor of our common home being celebrated by our brothers and sisters around the world.

This week's featured events:

- The Columban community of Essendon, Australia, together with friends working for peace, ecology and justice in Melbourne, held a **prayer service**.
- Over 100 people **planted mangroves** in Zamboanga, Philippines.
- The Divine Salvation Society of Pakistan organized a **prayer for the Earth** with 30 young people committed to environmental conservation.
- In Wirral, UK, they made a **pilgrimage for the planet** reflecting on lifestyles and water use, and prayed for the East African Oil Pipeline (EACOP).
- The Catholic University of Santos, in Sao Paulo, Brazil, held **student meetings** to discuss Laudato Si' and the socio-environmental crisis.
- **Students from the San Francisco de Asís High School** in Formosa, Argentina, held a workshop to raise awareness and reflect on environmental care.
- In Badajoz, Spain, **adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** was held as a contemplative prayer for the Care of Creation.


